WHAT IS A MEMORY SCREEN?

A memory screen is a simple tool meant to help evaluate your memory health and get a brain health baseline. It consists of three short tasks that look for any indicators of possible memory loss.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER THE SCREEN?

After the screen, you will be able to decide what you want to do with the information. If you wish we can send the result to your primary physician to review.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?

It will only take about 10-15 minutes to perform the memory screen.

WILL A MEMORY SCREEN DIAGNOSE ME WITH ALZHEIMER'S OR DEMENTIA?

No, it will not. A memory screen is only meant to look for possible indicators of memory loss. Your primary physician will be able to help you with your next steps.
